

Prof. dr. sc. Slobodan Danko Bosanac is president of the Adriatic Aerospace Association and its chief founder. His main professional carrier is within the Ruđer Bošković Institute and it is centred on the problems of atomic and molecular energy transfers, electromagnetic interactions, astrophysics and basic concepts of quantum and classical physics. Bosanac published around 100 papers, four books, was principal investigator in several international science projects and was actively involved in popularizing science by publishing and lecturing. For his research Bosanac received two Croatian State Prizes in science, in 1997 and 2013. In 1986 he initiated interdisciplinary conferences by bringing together scientists in physics, chemistry, astrophysics and more recently molecular biology to review and discuss important problems in science and technology that have common denominator to all of them. Since then the conferences run on a biannual basis under a general title Brijuni Conferences.
